Description





For days when the weather suggests that gaining altitude is not such a good idea, this is a pleasant short walk taking in the quieter part of the Leete path. There are two steep but short climbs, conditions can be muddy and slippery after wet weather and you may be walking through a field occupied by cows. Though they have never bothered me, walking with a dog may be a problem.

Start at the White Horse Inn and head down and into the Millennium Woods (Coed y Felin)



where you will pass our "badgers." Follow the path onto Trial Hill, cross the bridge and walk up the hill towards Pantymywn, turning right onto the Leete just before the hill top.

Carry on along the Leete pausing at Devil's Gorge where you may see climbers scaling the vertical walls.





Carry on past the gorge for 650 yards and then fork right off the Leete and cross the River Alyn on a footbridge. Proceed up the steep path to the Loggerheads road (there may be cows in this field). Cross the road and carry on up the Brithdir Mawr road turning right before a white cottage onto a farm track.

After a few minutes you will pass a barn and a large house on your right. At the end of the house's garden take the path to the right and cross the stile. Carry on to the Pentre and walk up the hill to Cilcain centre.
